



### MCNALLY SETTLES IN TO V8 UTES AT CLIPSAL 500 19 March 2009

Glenn McNally has qualified 13th today at Adelaide's Clipsal 500 for the first round of the V8 Utes Series.

After a late test session at nearby Mallala Raceway yesterday where the HiTech Motorsport crew tuned the car Glenn was ready to take on the concrete canyon on the streets of Adelaide today.

The first session today saw Glenn 17th fastest after running on tyres left over from the final 2008 round at Oran Park and bedding in some new brake pads.

"I just wanted to build up my lap times in the first session," Glenn said.

At one stage Glenn ran off the circuit at the final hairpin after being held up by slower competitors.

"There was no point going crazy out there because we didn't have any really good tyres before qualifying."

13th fastest was a good effort for the West Australian considering the last time he was here was his second V8 ute race ever.

"I have already gone a lot faster than last year which I can put down to my experience and also the dedication of the team to improve the car."

With championship points being awarded for qualifying for the first time this year Glenn is hoping to push well into the top ten in qualifying in future rounds as well as capitalising on his solid race pace.

Before race 1 tomorrow, Glen will examine his in-car footage to determine where he can get more out of himself and the car.

Race 1 is at 4.15pm tomorrow with race 2 on Saturday and race 3 on Sunday.
