



TOP TEN IN PRACTICE FOR MCNALLY IN FUJITSU V8S AT CLIPSAL 500

Mark McNally showed strong pace today to finish 8th fastest in practice for the Fujitsu V8 Supercars at Adelaide's Clipsal 500 today.

Without using any new tyres Mark was extremely happy with the speed of the car which gives him confidence going into tomorrow's qualifying.

"It is a bit hard to tell exactly where we are at as many drivers would have used new tyres today,' Mark said.

"I know that we have a fast car and it should get better when we run new tyres in qualifying tomorrow."

Mark's fastest lap time of 1:25.0 could have been a bit faster had he not been held up on two occasions.

"I think we should have been good for a 1:24.5 today but tomorrow is the important day as far as qualifying goes."

"We need to work on a few areas of the car overnight, it has a little too much push in the front but the power-down grip is good.

"Once we sort that out the car should be extremely well balance."

Mark has qualifying and race 1 tomorrow with race 2 on Saturday.
